





## Summer Crisis Program Begins July 1st-September 30th

Ross County Community Action is now scheduling appointments to assist individuals with their energy bills. The Home Energy Assistance, Summer Crisis Program, provides a one-time benefit to eligible Ohioans with cooling assistance during the summer months.

The Summer Crisis Program can provide assistance with electric utility bills, central air conditioning repairs, and air conditioning unit and/or fans.

Households at or below 175% of the federal poverty level that also meet one of the following requirements:

A household member who is either 60 years of age and older, OR
A household member has a certified medical condition, OR
The household has a disconnection notice, has been shut off, or a new electric service is being established may be eligible for assistance.

## What you need to bring to your appointment\*:



Last 30 days household income for anyone in the home



Copy of your most recent energy bill



All household members Date of birth and Social Security Numbers



Proof of citizenship for everyone in the home
